



Dress Code 2021-2022

Acceptable Daily Dress Code Attire:

- Clothing should be properly sized, not form fitting
- Clothing should completely cover undergarments and necessary parts of the body at all times including while sitting, standing, and bending over.
- Shirts with brand name logos (unless offensive)
- Shirts with name of college teams or professional teams (no pictures)
- Plaid, prints, and stripes are allowed
- Denim in good repair; not heavily faded or torn
- Leggings should be worn **ONLY** under modest length dresses, skirts, tunics, not as pants. Length of skirts, dresses, and tunics should be no higher than 3" above the knee.
- Dresses and skirts of modest length; this standard is in place even when girls are wearing leggings
- LCS and college sweatshirts and t-shirts
- Any clothing or personal appearance that tends to draw undue attention to the individual is not acceptable.
- Hats and hoods are to be worn outside only
- Hair is to be clean, neat, well-kept. Hair should not draw undue attention, and extreme styles are not permitted. Please consult with your principal if you have questions.

Not allowed:

- Cartoon or movie characters
- Thin, plain white t-shirts
- Shirts promoting one athlete
- Shirts promoting music groups
- Shirts with media advertising
- Shirts with offensive words or pictures
- Pants or shorts with writing on the backside
- Jeggings and leggings as pants
- Any form fitting, skin tight clothing
- Any "unnatural" hair color or any hair style that draws excessive attention to a student.

Dress Code Exceptions

- Special school spirit dress days - ie. Pajama day, hat day, etc...

It is the policy of LCS that students dress in conformance with one's biological sex.
