ACCEPTABLE	NOT ACCEPTABLE
MODESTY - Can be defined as making sure our bodies are covered in such a way as to honor the Lord and not to offend and/or tempt those around us.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clothing should be properly sized, not form fitting. Leggings should be worn ONLY under modest length dresses, skirts, tunics, not as pants. Length of skirts, dresses, and tunics should be no higher than 4" above the knee. Dresses and skirts of modest length; this standard is in place even when girls are wearing leggings. Clothing should completely cover undergarments and necessary parts of the body at all times including while sitting, standing, and bending over. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any form fitting, skin tight clothing. Thin, plain white t-shirts, tank tops or sleeveless undershirts. Sleeveless shirts. Jeggings and leggings as pants. Pants or shorts with writing on the backside.
HUMILITY - In a school setting, appropriate clothes are those that do not hinder the educational process or draw attention to oneself.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shirts with brand name logos (unless offensive). Shirts with names of college teams or professional teams (no pictures). LCS and college sweatshirts and t-shirts. Plaid, prints, and stripes are allowed. Hair is to be clean, neat, well-kept. Hair should not draw undue attention, and extreme styles are not permitted. Please consult with your principal if you have questions. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shirts promoting one athlete or music groups. or with cartoon or movie characters. Shirts with media advertising or with offensive words or pictures. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Clothing should be properly sized, not form fitting. ● Dresses and skirts of modest length (no higher than 3" above the knee) ● Clothing should completely cover undergarments and necessary parts of the body at all times including while sitting, standing, and bending over. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Any form fitting, skin tight clothing, including crop tops. ● Thin, plain white t-shirts, tank tops or sleeveless undershirts. ● Sleeveless shirts. ● Leggings and jeggings. ● Pants or shorts with writing on the backside. ● No rolling of waistbands or shirts with intent to shorten length. Clothing should be worn as designed.
